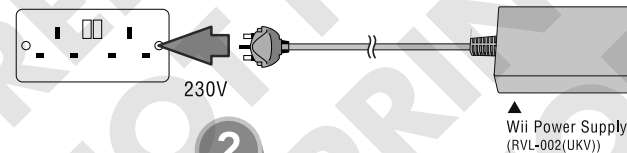
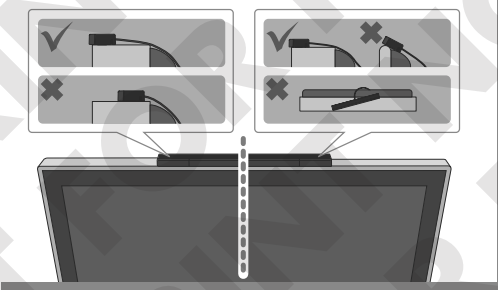

1 Installing the Sensor Bar

Remove the protective film from the double-sided adhesive tape on the bottom of the Sensor Bar. Make sure to align the centre of the Sensor Bar with the centre of the TV and align the front of the Sensor Bar with the front of the surface it is sitting on.



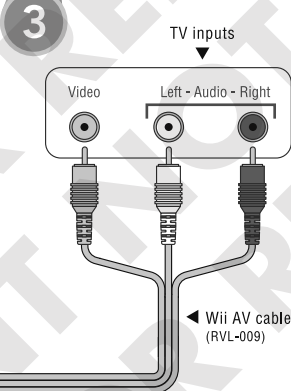
2 Wii Power Supply

Plug the Wii Power Supply into a power outlet after installing the Sensor Bar on the TV.



3 TV video/audio input

Set the correct AV input setting for your TV or other equipment.



4 Synchronising Your Wii Remote Plus

Any additional Wii Remote or Wii Remote Plus controllers you use with your console will first need to be synchronised. Press the POWER Button to turn on the Wii console, then press the SYNC. Buttons simultaneously as shown. The included Wii Remote Plus (RVL-036) should already be synchronised to your Wii console.
